Hello Corrina and council members, I trust all is well.

I would like to reopen the discussions around our parking issue at 105 Settlers Way in Blue Mountains. Last year we spoke to the Committee of the Whole and the response was that, while the Committee understood our situation (no driveway, access via easement), unfortunately there were no permanent solutions found for us at that time.

We just received a parking ticket on Saturday Sept 30th, while we were unloading the car, which I paid this morning.

Our understanding is that there were 2 parking spots assigned to the property at 105 Settlers Way, located at the end of the dead end street, towards Hwy 19, which were revoked once the city took over snow removal, several years ago. We are kindly asking the Committee of the Whole to reconsider the option of reinstating our parking spot at the end of Settlers Way, which is are still marked as "private parking".

As any other home owner in the Town of Blue Mountains, we need parking.
