

What is being proposed?

The purpose of this application is to consider a request for minor variance to subsection b) viii) of General Provision 6.20 *Accessory Apartment Units Within a Detached Structure* of the Town of Thornbury Zoning By-law 10-77 as amended. The Owner is seeking a minor variance to the height standards to permit the construction of a detached garage with an accessory apartment on the second floor.

The effect of the application is to permit an accessory apartment within a detached structure to be 7.74 metres in height, whereas a maximum of 4.5 metres is permitted.

The legal description of the subject lands is TOWN PLOT PARK LOT 14 ALICE W/S AND PARK LOT 14 ALFRED E/S
