Re: Lora Greens Development

I am writing on behalf of Tree Trust TBM regarding the proposed Lora Greens development and the request for rezoning and adoption of a draft plan of subdivision.

The Georgian Trail is one of our most important recreational assets and one of our most vital natural assets, serving as a unique vegetative corridor extending through our urban settlement areas. Maintaining the integrity of the Georgian Trail is of paramount importance. This includes, most importantly, protecting the tree canopy along this corridor.

The current plan of subdivision shows residential lots backing onto the Georgian Trail and as such, represents a potential threat to the trees and vegetative corridor along the Trail. The proposed plan should include explicit requirements to preserve the tree cover along the Trail (e.g., a minimum vegetative buffer/setback) and requirements concerning protection of trees and root zones during excavation and grading.

My hope is that Council and Staff take action to protect the vegetative corridor along the Georgian Trail through clear and enforceable design standards and construction practices.
