A. Recommendations

THAT Council receive Staff Report CSOPS.24.055, entitled "2024 Thornbury-Clarksburg Rotary Turkey Trot Subsidy Request";

AND THAT Council waive all fees for the 2024 Thornbury-Clarksburg Rotary Turkey Trot event to an upset limit of \$3000.00.

B. Overview

As per the direction of Council from the June 24, 2024, Council meeting and the deputation provided by Lucy Hilts of the Thornbury-Clarksburg Rotary Club, Staff are providing staff report CSOPS.24.055 entitled "2024 Thornbury-Clarksburg Rotary Turkey Trot Subsidy Request" showing financial details and costing for the event.

C. Background

At the Council meeting of June 24, 2024, Lucy Hilts of the Thornbury-Clarksburg Rotary Club, provided a deputation to Council requesting a waive of fees for the annual Thornbury-Clarksburg Rotary Turkey Trot event.

Council provided the following resolution:

"THAT Council of the Town of the Blue Mountains receives for information the deputation of Lucy Hilts, Thornbury Clarksburg Rotary Club, Re: Request for Council to waive the Beaver Valley Community Centre fee for the 2024 Turkey Trot taking place Friday October 11 and Saturday October 12, 2024;

AND THAT Council directs staff to provide a staff report regarding the requested waiving of the Beaver Valley Community Centre rental fee for the 2024 Turkey Trot taking place on Friday October 11 and Saturday October 12, 2024"

Provided within the analysis of this staff report are not only the costing for the Beaver Valley Community Centre but costing for all other services, properties and items requested for use for the event.

D. Analysis

The request from the Thornbury-Clarksburg Rotary Club has been a historical request through Council and the Grants and Donations Committee. Staff feel that this is a great opportunity to provide access to active living opportunities for the participants within the community and surrounding areas. The Thornbury Clarksburg Rotary Club use this event to raise funds for projects in the community. Any fees waived will be re-invested into the community.
