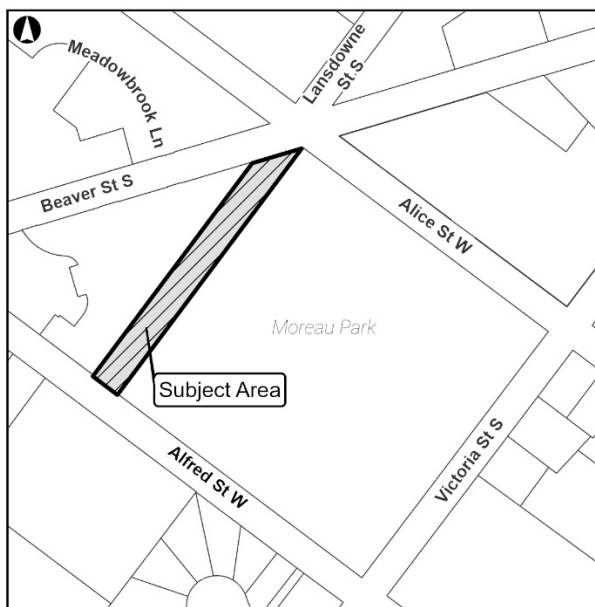

What is being proposed?

Lansdowne St. S unopened road allowance is located at the northwest end of Moreau Park between Alfred St. W and Alice St. W. Through the Moreau Park Revitalization project, preliminary assessments have indicated that this portion should proceed with a stop up and close process (See attached key map).

Verbal Comments – This Public Meeting is a hybrid meeting, allowing the public to attend the meeting in person or virtually. Those that wish to make verbal comments virtually are required to pre-register with the Town Clerk, no later than five business days in advance of the Public Meeting, **by 4:30 p.m. on Tuesday March 3, 2026**.
