C. Matters for Discussion

C.1 Discussion with Jeffery Campbell, Resident Re: Internet at Christie Beach/Sunset Boulevard

- DSL system with outdated nodes, but high internet costs
- COVID-19 emphasized the need for reliable internet services in the Christie Beach/Sunset Boulevard area
- Residents advocating for enhanced internet services went door-to-door in the area and received significant interest from property owners in the area
- Bell will be installing fibre in late 2020, early 2021 to upgrade the services, according to information provided to Mr. Campbell

C.2 Update from Blair Almond, Bruce Street Technologies Re: ICON Grant Application and Progress

- Received 1st round approvals, and currently working on second round application
- Summit View/Fawcett Lane services installed and functioning
- Stabtown area services requires road works, which has been approved by the Town's Operations Department – anticipated installation start date: week of November 9, 2020
- Discussed that potential timing of water line installation for fruit growers may not align with fibre installation

C.3 FCM Broadband Master Class Webinar – Deputy Mayor Potter

- Reviewed summary document provided by Deputy Mayor Potter regarding the FCM Broadband Master Class webinar
- Fibre offers the most potential for expansion
- Discussed that mapping which includes all known underground infrastructure will be needed Shawn Carey and Blair Almond to investigate further

C.4 Follow-up to Discussion with Municipality of Grey Highlands and Municipality of Meaford regarding Potential Interest in Broadband Provision – CAO Shawn Everitt

• Sarah Merrifield, on behalf of Shawn Everitt, confirmed the Grey Highlands and Meaford Chief Administrative Officers are interested in the broadband work being undertaken and have been invited to the November 18, 2020 Task Force meeting

C.7 Hydro One Utility and Right-of-Way Use Research – Director of Operations Shawn Carey

- Franchise agreements in place with hydro providers to allow for right-of-way access, but no ability to leverage rental/occupancy fees
 - However, municipalities can collect fees associated with work permits, road closure fees, staff time costs, etc.
