To The Town of the Blue Mountains Council,

I am writing in regard to the amended motion passed by the Committee of the Whole, permitting BTI a temporary exemption to the Town Noise Bylaw.

Clearly the existing Bylaw should not be modified. I cannot imagine how any of the Councilors can think it reasonable for a nearby resident, who must get up early for work or school, to have their sleep interrupted nightly between the hours of say 9 to 11pm! For a year!

Further, I'm not sure how allowing the Bylaw to change for a year will help Council to make an informed long-term decision about this situation.

Perhaps all the Councilors should take their i-phones out, set an alarm for every 15 minutes between 9:00pm and 11:00pm, 6 days a week, for a year!

I strongly urge them to vote in favour of maintaining the existing by-law.
