Hello Mayor,

As I'm sure you're aware the intersection at 4th Line and the 6th Side Road (Gibraltar) is traffic heavy.

We are currently building in this area and there are at least 3 more houses on the horizon, at this intersection.

I visit my build, on occasion, and have witnessed 3 cars blow the stop sign at high speed, some even rapidly honking their horn. This brings a lot of worry to my husband and I as we have two small children and our main entrance to our house is off the 4th, at the intersection.

There are options here and I'd like counsel to review and discuss what option is best for the intersection before someone loses a life. The speed at which people fly through here has to be 100km/hr, they simply don't see the sign enough in advance.

1. Larger Stop sign (seen from down the road, coming from the South) 2. Red blinking light above stop sign (seen from down the road, coming from the South) 3. Kids at play signs 4. Yellow flashers (seen from down the road, coming from the South)

There are a tremendous amount of bikers in this area and I'd hate to see anyone fall victim to this busy road.
