Good day Mr. Forrest,

I reside, along with my husband, [REDACTED] at [REDACTED] Bay Street East, immediately north of Astec/BTI property.

In advance of the Town of Blue Mountains Council meeting on May 9, 2022, in which the motion to allow your company a temporary exemption to the existing noise by-law from the hours of 7 pm to 11 pm will be put forward, can you respond to the following questions:

1. If the permission is granted, specifically what will change in your operations between the hours of 7 pm to 11 pm from the current status?
2. If the permission is granted, will there be more noise than there currently is between the hours of 7 pm and 11 pm? If so, please explain what activities will be causing the increased noise?

In addition, in the October 4, 2021 letter from BTI/Astec to Council, reference is made to the company's compliance with the MOECC Environmental Compliance Approval requirement for air and noise. You also made reference in the April 26, 2022 Committee of the Whole meeting that a record of noise report exists. Will you share with neighbours, Mayor Soever and Council the data from any noise assessments that the company, or anyone acting on the company's behalf, or any agency of any level of government, has already conducted in the past 5 years?

Thank you in advance for responding to these questions. Your answers should help to ensure an informed discussion of this matter at the May 9<sup>th</sup> TBM Council Meeting. I will send a copy of this message to Mayor Soever and Council. My husband, Cim Nunn, will also be making a deputation to the May 9<sup>th</sup> Council meeting that will request the information that I am requesting in this message.
