### Application for a Minor Variance to Zoning By-law 2018-65

Property Location: Lot 81, Plan 16M-86  
(Courtland Street)

### What is being proposed?

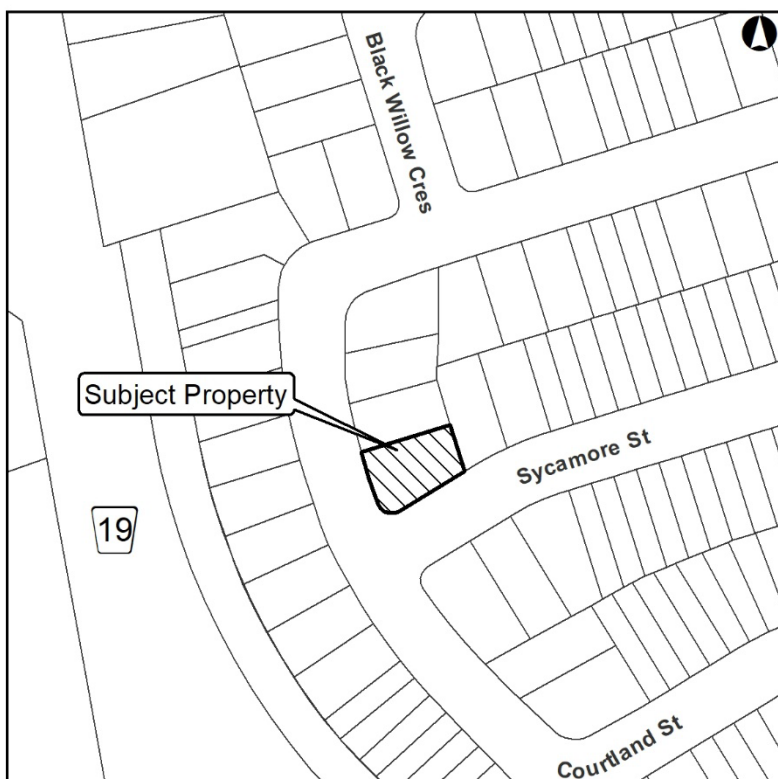
The purpose of this application is to consider a request for minor variance to the *Residential One (R1-3)* provisions of Zoning By-law 2018-65. The following variances are included in the request:

1. To permit a minimum exterior side yard setback of 4.5m for the proposed dwelling unit, whereas a minimum of 6.0m is required in the R1-3-62 zone.

The effect of the application is to permit the construction of a new single detached dwelling unit on an irregular shaped parcel of land.

The legal description of the subject lands is Lot 81, Plan 16M-86.
