A. Recommendations

THAT Council receive Staff Report FAF.22.129, entitled “Amendment to By-law 2018-67”;

AND THAT Council enact an amendment to By-law No. 2018-67, as amended, being a By-law to appoint Municipal Law Enforcement Officers, that would update the list of persons appointed as Municipal Law Enforcement Officers for the purposes of enforcing specific parking related by-laws of the municipality on specific lands.

B. Overview

The purpose of this report is to outline an amendment to By-law No. 2018-67, as amended, being a By-law to appoint Municipal Law Enforcement Officers (MLEOs), that would update the list of persons appointed as MLEOs to enforce specific parking related by-laws on specific lands.

C. Background

On December 17, 2018 Council enacted By-law No. 2018-67 to appoint Municipal Law Enforcement Officers for the purposes of enforcing specific parking related by-laws of the municipality on specific lands.

We have received a request from Blue Mountain Resorts Security to add Nathan Daniels, Jacob Mather, Isabel Van Buynder, Vishnu Sankarankutty, Andrew Turnbull, Skyler Wright and Justin Antolick to the list of persons appointed as MLEOs. They have also requested that William Bostock, Andrew Uren, Tamara Tomes, Jake Zavitz, Alexander McKean, Darrell Morrison, Pablo Jacome, Puneet Gill be removed from the list of persons appointed as MLEOs.

Additionally, we have received a request from Chime Security to add Paris Thind, Mandeep Aoulkh and Philip Lehman to the list of persons appointed as MLEOs. They have also requested that Gary Ferguson, Joshua Hockley and Jessie Miske be removed from the list of appointed MLEOs.

Schedule “A” of the attached draft amending By-law outlines the revised list of appointed MLEOs and the associated lands as noted in the “Property” column on which they are authorized to enforce specific parking-related by-laws.

D. Analysis

Appointing third-party personnel as Municipal Law Enforcement Officers for the purpose of parking enforcement on private lands allows effective parking control to be exercised, without additional costs to the Town.
