By-Law Number 2023 -

Being a By-law to amend By-law No. 2022-49, Being a By-law to regulate the parking, standing, and stopping of motor vehicles on roads and properties under the jurisdiction of the Town of The Blue Mountains

Whereas Section 100.1 of the *Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c.25* ("The Municipal Act, 2001") enables a local municipality to enact a by-law to regulate or prohibit the parking or leaving of a vehicle on privately-owned land that is used as a parking lot without the consent of the owner of the land;

And Whereas Section 101 of the *Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c.25* enables a local municipality to enact a by-law to provide for the removal and impounding or restraining and immobilizing of a motor vehicle on privately-owned land without the consent of the owner of the motor vehicle and at the motor vehicle owner's expense;

And Whereas Section 101 (3) of the *Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c.25* provides that where signs are erected on land specifying conditions on which a motor vehicle may be parked or left on the land or regulating or prohibiting the parking or leaving of a motor vehicle, a motor vehicle parked or left on the land contrary to the conditions or prohibition shall be deemed to have been parked or left without consent;

And Whereas Section 170 (15) of the *Highway Traffic Act*, R.S.O. 1990, applies in the instance of the removal and impounding of a motor vehicle on privately owned land;

And Whereas the Council of the Corporation of the Town of The Blue Mountains has enacted By- law No. 2022-49, a By-law to regulate the parking, standing, and stopping of motor vehicles on roads and properties under the jurisdiction of the Town of The Blue Mountains;

And Whereas Council has received Staff Report FAF.23.027 "Amendment to By-law 2022-49, Being a By-law to regulate the parking, standing and stopping of motor vehicles on roads and properties under the jurisdiction of the Town of The Blue Mountains, and By-law 2018-67, being a By-law to appoint Municipal Law Enforcement Officers";

And Whereas the Council of the Corporation of the Town of The Blue Mountains deems it appropriate to amend By-law No. 2022-49;

Now Therefore Council of The Corporation of the Town of The Blue Mountains hereby enacts as follows:

1. That the "Schedules" section be amended to include Schedules "R" and "S" to the by-law.

And Further that this By-law shall come into force and take effect upon the enactment thereof.


