A. Recommendations

THAT Council receive Staff Report FAF.23.034, entitled "Roles and Responsibilities of Council Members on The Blue Mountains Attainable Housing Corporation Board" for information.

B. Overview

The purpose of this report is to provide a follow up for Council to outline the roles and responsibilities of Council Representatives appointed as "Director" on The Blue Mountains Attainable Housing Corporation Board.

C. Background

At the January 23, 2023, Council meeting, Council received a <u>Deputation from The Blue Mountains Attainable Housing Corporation</u> and subsequently recommended that Mayor Matrosovs and Councillor McKinlay be appointed as the Town's Representatives on The Blue Mountains Attainable Housing Corporation Board of Directors for 2022-2024.

D. Analysis

Staff engaged Mr. John Mascarin of Aird & Berlis to provide a legal opinion to be shared in an open session of Council, as specifically requested by the Town of The Blue Mountains, that outlines answers to a series of questions that management believes would be beneficial for Council and the public.

The Blue Mountains Attainable Housing Corporation previously had work completed by Robins Appleby as outlined in <u>Staff Report FAF.21.038</u> and the two opinions are consistent in their findings.

Staff also provided this opinion to The Blue Mountains Attainable Housing Corporation Chair Gavin Leitch, and Executive Director, Jennifer Bisely in advance of this report being released.
