#### A. Recommendations

THAT Council receive Staff Report FAF.23.032, entitled "2022 Statement of Council Remuneration and Expenses" as required under Section 284 of the Municipal Act, 2001, for information purposes.

#### B. Overview

This report outlines the 2022 remuneration and expenses paid to Council and Committee of Adjustment members, as legislatively required.

#### C. Background

Pursuant to Section 284 (1) of the Municipal Act, 2001:

The treasurer of a municipality shall in each year on or before March 31 provide to the council of the municipality an itemized statement on remuneration and expenses paid in the previous year to:

- Each member of council in respect of his or her services as a member of the council or any other body, including a local board, to which the member has been appointed by council or on which the member holds office by virtue of being a member of council;
- b) Each member of council in respect of his or her services as an officer or employee of the municipality or other body described in clause (a); and
- c) Each person, other than a member of council, appointed by the municipality to serve as a member of any body, including a local board, in respect of his or her services as a member of the body. 2001, c. 25, s. 284 (1).

Section 284(2) of the Municipal Act, 2001:

The statement shall identify the by-law under which the remuneration or expenses were authorized to be paid.

- a) By-law 2020-18
- b) Committee of Adjustment Remuneration Policy approved March 25, 2013
