As a local resident, (Fraser Crescent), near the Parkbridge development now underway, I would like to voice some concerns I have about upcoming blasting for this new development.

Since Parkbridge is obviously getting down to bedrock on the site, how will this impact water run-off in relation to its neighbours?

Water from the hill must exit to the lake (at some point). We currently have drainage issues on this crescent made obvious by the heavy rains we just received this January 3-4<sup>th</sup> 2023.

Insurance policies have risen here or are difficult to attain. Is the town and contractor willing to compensate for any unforeseen problems associated with this activity?

Another question is: How will all this shaking affect our foundations/windows, sewage/water lines etc.? I recognize you have seismic equipment monitoring but that does not guarantee anything or the cumulative effect of all that shaking. I am glad I'm not immediately next door to this. I am disappointed that in this day and age of environmental degradation that this has been allowed to proceed.

I am not the only one here that feels this way.
