The purpose of my presentation is drawn from a 51 year career in investment banking and wealth management, as well as being an active participant in the community for 49 years.

My purpose before Council is to reveal the deficiencies, risks, and true nature of the TC Energy project -- to create a storage facility on the Escarpment in the context of water drawn from Georgian Bay.

Deficiencies include: corporate history of poorly managed projects; fault-ridden financial viability; antiquated technology; inability to mitigate needs of future demands for reliable hydro.

Risks include: contamination in the Georgian Bay basin; release and accelerating discharge of toxins; unforeseen damage to land/water/shoreline resources; long-term degradations; future decommissioning failure.

True nature includes: secret framework of negotiations between TC and governmental agencies; commitments to the community; greenwashing.
