A. Recommendations

THAT Council receive Staff Report CSOPS.24.042, entitled "Kubota 6060 Tractor Emergency Repairs";

AND THAT Council approve the emergency repair costs of \$15,000 for the Kubota 6060 Tractor.

B. Overview

Staff are providing this report as per the purchasing policy. The User Division shall submit a memorandum to Council outlining the purchase and the conditions that constituted an emergency, together with a source of funding, prior to the end of the quarter in which the emergency procurement took place. If Council approval for the funding source is required, the User Division shall submit the above information in the form of a Staff Report to the next available Council meeting.

C. Background

Staff had the Kubota 6060 tractor taken to a dealer for repairs after their inspection of damage to the hydrostatic transmission. The service technician reported that the transmission would need to be replaced.

The damage was due to a failed bearing inside the hydrostatic transmission housing causing damage to the gears inside leaving the tractor inoperable.

The bearing failure caused the damage and not staff negligence.

The unforeseen repairs will exceed 2024 approved operating budget for equipment repairs and maintenance.

D. Analysis

The Kubota Tractor is inoperable unless the dealer completes the repairs.

The Kubota Tractor is a vital part of the day-to-day operations of the parks and trails which include grass cutting, trail maintenance and snow removal.
