AND THAT Council approve the revised funding structure, allocating 50% recovery from Development Charges (DCs) and 50% recovery from the Community Services Asset Replacement Reserve Fund, in accordance with the DC Background Study;

AND THAT Council authorize the Mayor and Clerk to execute any necessary agreements with the Ontario Ministry of Transportation (MTO) and Housing, Infrastructure and Communities Canada (HICC) (formerly Infrastructure Canada or INFC), as required for the subject works. CARRIED
