Explore the permanent closure of Alice Street East road allowance

Assume the unopened road allowance as part of the Town's trail network

Protect the trees on town-owned property

Secure the trail access in perpetuity

Plot the Beaver River Trail on the OP Schedule B2



Amend PLU-COR-07-04 to exclude the Beaver River Trail from Delegated Authority to the Committee of Adjustment

Trail access belongs to the people

The trees belong to the people
