Title: 2025 Budget Estimates Follow up & 2025 Budget By-Law

#### A. Recommendations

THAT Council receive Staff Report CFS.25.016, entitled "2025 Budget Estimates Follow up and 2025 Budget By-Law" for information;

AND THAT Council approve the By-Law to adopt the estimates of all sums required for 2025 for Town purposes.

#### B. Overview

This report presents an update on the 2025 Draft Budget, incorporating amendments as per Council's direction from the Committee of the Whole meeting held on February 24, 2025.

# C. Background

The 2025 Draft Budget has been reviewed by Council and the Public over a series of meetings throughout 2025. Following the January 27, 2025 Council meeting the 2025 Draft Budget had a Municipal Levy of \$23,091,910 which equated to a tax rate increase of 6.15% over 2024.

A Public Meeting seeking public input on the 2025 Draft Budget was held on February 18, 2025 and staff provided a follow-up report to Council on February 24, 2025. Council provided additional direction to staff regarding the public input which is outlined in the analysis section below.

# D. Analysis

# **2025 Draft Operating Budget**

Council provided the following direction at the February 24, 2025 Committee of the Whole Meeting regarding the 2025 Draft Budget:

1. Motion: Set the remuneration for The Blue Mountains OPP Detachment Board to \$300 annually per member, for the Provincial and Public Appointees

**Response/Impact**: This represents an increase of \$600 to the Draft 2025 Budget. Staff have absorbed this into the 2025 Draft Budget and therefore there is no impact to the Municipal Levy.

2. Motion: Council direct staff to include in the 2025 budget, \$25,000 for the Meaford Hospital Foundation, to be funded from the Health Reserve

**Response/Impact:** Staff have included a \$25,000 grant expense in Health and Social Services for the Meaford Hospital Foundation. This expense is funded from a reserve transfer of \$25,000 from the Health Services Reserve.

The inclusion of these two items in the 2025 Draft Budget leaves the Municipal Levy unchanged at \$23,091,910.

Staff have updated the Water Consumption revenue estimates for 2025 based on updated information. Water is user fee funded and this increase in revenue was offset by an increase in net reserve/reserve fund transfers.

#### **2025 Draft Capital Budget**

Council provided direction to staff to include priority projects identified by the Craigleith Community Working Group in the 2025 Draft Budget. In addition, during the budget process staff identified capital budget amounts from previous years that required carryforward into the 2025 Draft Budget. The capital budget walk below outlines the changes from the January 28, 2025 version of the Draft Budget (Draft 2) to the proposed final draft of the 2025 Budget.

The Town's 2025 Draft Budget has a municipal tax rate increase of 6.15% over 2024 which equates to an additional \$130 annually for the average assessed home of \$530,000 for the Town's portion of the municipal taxes.
