A. Recommendations

THAT Council receive Staff Report OPS.25.014, entitled "Replacement of Substandard Watermain Phase 3" project status report for information.

B. Overview

This report provides Council with an update on the cancellation of the 125 Peel Street Servicing Project, designed to accommodate the Campus of Care development. With the termination of the Campus of Care project, Town staff will not proceed with the associated servicing infrastructure and will instead focus on the originally planned substandard watermain upgrades for Peel Street, Alice Street, and Baring Street.

C. Background

The original project focused on replacing substandard watermains but was modified as per <u>Staff</u> <u>Report CSOPS.23.038</u> when the Town initiated the Campus of Care project to include full servicing – water, wastewater, stormwater, and urbanization of Peel Street South. On November 12, 2024, Council formally terminated the Campus of Care project (<u>Staff Report</u> <u>FAF.24.144</u>) following unsuccessful negotiations with development partners. Consequently, the Town will revert to its original substandard watermain upgrade plan.

D. Analysis

With the cancellation of the 125 Peel Street Servicing project, Town staff will proceed with the following actions:

- 1. Substandard Watermain Upgrades
 - a. Replacement of existing substandard watermains on Peel Street, Alice Street and Baring Street.
 - b. Retention of existing road configurations without full urbanization.

- 2. Cancellation of Additional Servicing Components
 - a. Water and wastewater servicing on Peel Street South will not proceed.
 - b. Planned road urbanization for Peel Street South, including storm sewer, will be removed from the project scope.

Other infrastructure enhancements that were tied to the Campus of Care will not be implemented with this project.

E. Strategic Priorities

1. Communication and Engagement

We will enhance communications and engagement between Town Staff, Town residents and stakeholders

2. Organizational Excellence

We will continually seek out ways to improve the internal organization of Town Staff and the management of Town assets.

3. Community

We will protect and enhance the community feel and the character of the Town, while ensuring the responsible use of resources and restoration of nature.

4. Quality of Life

We will foster a high quality of life for full-time and part-time residents of all ages and stages, while welcoming visitors.

F. Environmental Impacts

The revised project reduces environmental disruption by limiting construction to watermain replacement rather than full servicing. Maintaining the current rural road profile will help preserve existing natural elements.

G. Financial Impacts

The termination of the Campus of Care project and with it the 125 Peel Street Servicing project has resulted in a significant reduction in overall capital project costs. The detailed costs incurred for these projects and the funding sources will be the subject of a separate staff report.

The Substandard Watermain Replacement project is included in the approved 2025 capital budget with a total project cost of \$6,185,000. Funding for this project is budgeted to come from grants and reserve funds. Estimated expenditures for this project in 2025 are \$3,736,138.
