(Part 4) of the Ontario Heritage Act***

OHA Designation Steps:

- Notice of intention to designate posted (NOID)
- 30 day appeal period
- Designation bylaw enacted within 120 days of publication of NOID (Tree Trust can provide “statement of cultural interest” and “description of the heritage attributes”)
- Enact the designated by law
