## FOR COUNCIL CONSIDERATION

We are writing to request that Parking be permitted on Carmichael Crescent in Blue Mountains.

As background:

- Our primary residence is situated at [REDACTED] Carmichael Crescent
- This property has been in our family since it was originally built in 1977 (we are 3<sup>rd</sup> generation owners)
- Over 48 years, we have had without exaggeration, 100s of friends and family members park on the street when our driveway is full. No one has ever been ticketed for doing so until our son visited us on July 27, 2025.
- We were unaware that parking was prohibited (as were our neighbours). We know there is no parking near the two Stop signs at the entrances (there are No Parking signs at each entrance), but believed parking was permitted everywhere else.
- There are no "No Parking" signs visible from either side of our driveway (see photos included with this email).
- We have introduced hundreds of people to this beautiful town and they have supported the town's restaurants, shops and ski resort. We want them to be able to park, short term, on our street, outside our home.
- We would also like to understand how parking decisions are made, when Carmichael Crescent was designated "no parking both sides, full length" and what we need to do to have this designation changed.
