Dear Madame Mayor and Members of Council:

On May 13, 2024, Council adopted a motion recognizing that our Town's natural landscapes, built heritage, cultural traditions, and vital agricultural lands are foundational to our identity and long-term prosperity and directing staff to (1) develop and disseminate tools to help residents actively participate in preservation, and (2) establish a Municipal Heritage Task Force to assist in drafting Terms of Reference for a subsequent Municipal Heritage Advisory Committee, as contemplated in the Town's Official Plan.

To date, no public update has been brought forward to establish the Municipal Heritage Task Force or to outline the resident engagement tools contemplated in the motion. The Blue Mountains Historical Society (BMHS) respectfully requests a public status update, including next steps and timelines, on the implementation of Council's May 13, 2024 direction.
