For Council Consideration Regarding the Notice of Motion for the Redwing Community Safety Zone at April 20th council meeting:

We would like to express our sincere gratitude to Councillor June Porter for bringing forward this Notice of Motion, and to Council as a whole for continuing to give thoughtful consideration to the safety concerns in our Redwing community.

It has now been nearly a year since we first appeared before Council, supported by our neighbours, to speak about the urgent need to address speeding in our hamlet. We are deeply appreciative of the steps that have been taken since then—particularly the direction to staff to develop a Community Safety Zone policy. These actions have given our community hope that meaningful progress is underway.

At the same time, as residents living with the day-to-day realities of unsafe traffic conditions, we remain concerned about the pace of that progress. The risks we described in our deputation—limited visibility, lack of sidewalks, and frequent excessive speeding—continue to pose a very real threat to the safety of our families and neighbours.

We are encouraged by this Notice of Motion, which seeks clarity, accountability, and momentum. We respectfully echo its intent and express our hope that Town staff will respond with a clear update and a practical plan to ensure that this important work continues without further delay.

Our request has always been simple: that Redwing be recognized for its unique safety challenges, and that reasonable steps be taken to help protect those who live, walk, and play here. We believe this motion is an important step toward that goal.

Thank you again to Councillor Porter and to Council for your leadership and continued commitment to community safety. We remain hopeful and appreciative of your efforts to move this forward.
