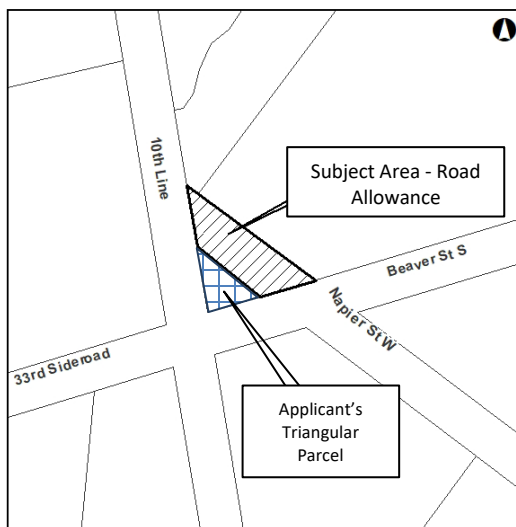
### What is being proposed?

The Town has received a request to consider "Stopping up and Closing" a portion of the Napier Street West unopened road allowance located in the area shown on the map below. The purpose of the request is to consider a land exchange involving the unopened Napier Street West Road allowance and a portion of lands owned by the applicant at the corner of 10th Line and Beaver Street South.

The proposed exchange would allow for the transfer of the unopened road allowance to the applicant and the triangular portion of land located at the corner of 10th Line and Beaver Street South to the Town.
