





# Servicing

- A Preliminary site drainage plan has been completed to demonstrate that overland flow routes to the municipal drain can be achieved
- Development will be serviced via an internal low-pressure forcemain sanitary sewer system that will outlet to the existing Highway 26 gravity sanitary sewer
- Domestic water supply for the development will be provided via a connection to the existing Town of The Blue Mountain watermain within the Long Point Road right-of-way
