#### A. Recommendations

THAT Council receive Staff Report CSOPS.20.065, entitled "Remembrance Day Noise By-law Relief and Temporary Road Closure;

AND THAT Council provide relief to the noise by-law on Remembrance Day, November 11, 2020, from 10:00a.m. until noon at 229 Bruce Street, Thornbury;

AND THAT Council provide relief to the noise by-law on Remembrance Day, November 11, 2020, from noon until 2:00p.m. at 628299 Grey Road 119, Ravenna;

AND THAT Council approve the temporary road closure of Bruce Street South from the intersection of Bruce Street South and Marsh Street southwest to the intersection of Duncan Street East/West, and Duncan Street East from the intersection of Duncan Street East/West southeast to Russell Street West, allowing access for local traffic only from 8:00a.m. until 1:00p.m.

#### B. Overview

The Royal Canadian Legion Branch 05-281 Beaver Valley-Thornbury will be providing modified Remembrance Day Services at 229 Bruce Street South. This will be completed in partnership with the Town, including The Blue Mountains Public Library livestreaming the service to achieve a safe online event.

The Legion will be using amplified speakers to produce enough sound to create a quality livestream event.

Although there will not be a public gathering for this year's service, the purpose for the temporary road closures will be to setup, cleanup and limit vehicle noise to improve the sound quality for the livestream.

# C. Background


Local Remembrance Day ceremonies are extremely important to the community as a means of commemorating those in the armed forces, past and present.

Section 3e) of the Noise By-law permits the making of noises or sounds related to the non-residential use of land permitted by a by-law enacted by the municipality pursuant to the applicable Zoning By-law from 07:00 to 19:00. It is noted that outdoor events in themselves outside of 07:00 to 19:00 are not prohibited, however, the making of noise is prohibited in the instance where such events are likely to disturb the peace, quiet, comfort or repose of any inhabitant.

In accordance with the procedures set out in the Town's Policy and Procedures for Noise By-law Relief Requests, notices to the residents within 120 meters of the event locations were circulated for all events. Due to the timing of the application, the deadline for residents to submit comments exceeds the date of submission for this report. As of the date of submission of this report no responses were received.

Typically, the Ravenna Hall is utilized for a post-service luncheon provided by the community. This year the Ravenna Hall will not be utilized due to the current pandemic restrictions.

Staff are recommending an exemption to the noise by-law and road closure to enhance the quality of production for the online service. If the exemption and road closure are not approved, it will reduce the quality of the online event.
