# A. Recommendations

THAT Council receive Staff Report FAF.21.123, entitled "Website Design Options";

AND THAT Council acknowledges at the June 9, 2021 Special Meeting, the Community Communications Advisory Committee selected design option #3 as the preferred website design option with an increased focus on news and headlines;

AND THAT Council selects design option # \_\_\_\_\_\_ as the approved website design option for the new Town of The Blue Mountains municipal website;

AND THAT Council grants the Chief Administrative Officer final authority to approve the website design based on incorporating feedback from the Community Communications Advisory Committee and Council.

# B. Overview

This report provides Council with an overview of the three draft website design options and provides insight into the feedback received at the June 9, 2021 Special Meeting of the Community Communications Advisory Committee.

# C. Background

As part of the website redevelopment project, UpAnUp has drafted and presented three homepage design options for consideration. Each design was developed following the project goals and design criteria as outlined within the Request-for-Proposal.

## Key Project Goals

- Improving the end user experience;
- Improving the overall design and function of the website;
- Streamlining and simplifying site navigation;
- Improving website content searchability;

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- Increasing staff backend productivity; and
- Ensuring full accessibility and security compliance.

## Homepage Criteria

As directed within the Request-for-Proposal, the homepage designs are to include:

- Main website navigation, Town logo and prominently displayed search bar
- Slider/ banner image
- Latest news section that displays the most recent press releases with a link to view more
- Upcoming meetings section that displays the next upcoming meetings with link to view more
- Featured projects section that highlights three (3) to five (5) featured projects
- Municipal social media feeds
- Council meeting live stream alert box
- Most popular content section that is updated dynamically based on user activity
- A to Z services directory

## D. Analysis

The three design options were presented by UpAnUp to the Town and the CCAC Website Sub-Committee on Wednesday, June 2, 2021. Following the meeting, Town staff provided initial design comments and changes back to UpAnUp. These changes were reflected within the design options presented at the Special Meeting of the Community Communications Advisory Committee held on June 9, 2021.

At the meeting on June 9, the Community Communications Advisory Committee passed the following motion:

THAT the Community Communications Advisory Committee receive Staff Report FAF.21.113, entitled "Presentation of Website Design Options";

AND THAT the Community Communications Advisory Committee endorse design option # 3 as the preferred website design option with an increased focus on news and headlines to be relayed to Council for consideration at the June 14, 2021 Council meeting, CARRIED.

In addition to the motion, the Committee had a detailed discission and provided feedback about all three website design options. A general summary of the feedback is included below:

- Need to ensure email subscription option is available on internal webpages
- Less passive, more interactive content that focuses on headlines/news, etc. and does not require the user to actively search for important content
  - More specifically, balance the prominence between news and events
- More prominent display of the ExploreBlue.ca website to direct visitors

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- Important that functionality between mobile, tablet and desktop viewing and experience is seamless
- Links to online services should be more prominent
- The designs feature a good balance between content/visuals/white space

### Website Design Options

Town staff would like to highlight and emphasize that a detailed presentation of the preferred design option #3 as selected by the Community Communications Advisory Committee will be provided by UpAnUp during the Council meeting. The attachment to this staff report provides a static and non-interactive view of the three website design options.
