It would be very helpful to have a pedestrian-controlled crosswalk at Elgin and 26. This would not have to be a crossing with a signal light as is in place by the bridge as that would be an unnecessary expense and cause traffic delay. Also accessing the water at Bayview Park is quite difficult with the rock protection put in recently at the shore. I understand the need for the rocks during storming weather. Could a path be cleared or alternatively a boardwalk bridge be built to allow people to access the water safely? I was surprised that this was not done when the rocks were put in.
