

- Facilitating PK studies on novel ingredients.
- Investigating Immune outcomes on supplements for 60+.
- Establishing safety and efficacy for a novel drug for treating atopic dermatitis.
- Research on a dietary supplement for allergy relief.
- Testing efficacy for new antigen COVID test kits.
- Investigating a medical device for intraoperative microscopic diagnosis.
- Performing a proof of concept trial for a medical device to measure fluid out put after heart surgery.
- Investigating an ocular device for retinae detection.

Our plans in Town of The Blue Mountains (TBM)

- Open an Innovation Center that will function as a catalyst for economic development and diversification in the health, science and technology sectors in TBM area.
- The Innovation Center will connect researchers, industry partners and funding agencies and will support ongoing subject recruitment for all phases of clinical research studies.
- Approach will consist of three phases.
- Opportunity to put TBM on the innovation and scientific development map!





Fostering Innovation Through Community




Phase 1

- Utilization of existing clinic space at The Blue Mountains Community Health Centre.
- Help to facilitate subject recruitment and clinical conduct in this region for ongoing clinical trials.
- Hire for three positions: Director of Operations,
 Clinical Research Coordinator, Clinical Recruitment Lead.
- Timelines: Happening now.



Phase 2

- Retrofit existing utility building at 787466
 Grey Road 13.
- 4000 square feet of clinic and office space.
- Building and street signage as Town of the Blue Mountains Innovation Centre.
- Space will be used for planning and conduct of clinical trials.
- Approximately 15 people will be hired within first 12 months of opening.
- Timelines: 6-8 months from opening.
- Pre-consultation process meet with TBM
 Development Review Committee May 12,
 2022
- Objective is to initiate an application for a temporary zoning change.






Phase 3

- Open a 10000 square foot facility as part of the proposed healthcare campus in TBM.
- Will serve as a research institute for ongoing cutting edge research in all product categories related to health and wellness.
- Up to 40 employees, with expertise in clinical trial management, quality control, data monitoring, phlebotomists, nurses, etc.
- Payroll expected to be \$3-\$4 million, going back into the community.
- An environment for private enterprises investing in research to create meaningful connections with key community partners, working together to develop future innovations in science and healthcare in TBM.
- Timelines: Scheduled completion for 2025-26.
